

Required Tools

• 7/16" Combination wrench

Phillips screwdriver


Installation

- One electrical kit will be installed per locker and they may be wired together.
 Check with local officials regarding code requirements before installing.
 Wenger Corporation suggests not wiring more than five outlet boxes together/per circuit.
- 2. Start at the first locker and attach an outlet box to the inside rear of the top grilles using two connect plates, 1/4-20 x 3/4" carriage bolts and 1/4-20 lock nuts.



Each additional electrical kit will be connected using an included UL approved 2" box spacer that must be attached to the adjoining outlet box before it is mounted.


See Step 3 on the following page before mounting additional outlet boxes.



Installation (continued)

- 3. Make the electrical connections using a licensed electrician.

 There are several openings in the outlet box to route power through.
 - a. Outlet boxes may be connected together by removing the "knock-outs" and using UL approved electrical metallic tubing (emt) connectors. Knock-outs must not be removed unless a connection is made to another unit.
 - For convenience, a UL approved 2" box spacer has been provided (Garvin® BB-1/2-2).
 - Wenger Corporation suggests not wiring more than five outlet boxes together/per circuit.
 - Connect an adjoining outlet box before mounting it into to the next locker.
 - b. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 to attach and connect the next outlet box before proceeding to Step 4.



Installation (continued)

5. Attach the front bracket to the outlet box using four 8-32 x 3/16" machine screws.
