


# **Required Tools**

 1/2" Combination wrench and ratchet with 1/2" socket Phillips screwdriver

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
### **Parts List**

1	1	Frame
2	1	Inside Tube
3	2	Bumper
4	4	#6 x 1/2" Drill/tap Screw
5	2	5/16-18 x 2-1/4" Capscrew
6	1	Outside Tube
7	16	5/16-18 x 5/8" Capscrew
8	2	Nonswivel Caster
9	4	5/16-18 x 1-1/2" Capscrew
10	24	5/16-18 Lock Nut
11	2	Swivel Caster
12	3	7/8" x 14" Velcro



Nota Chair configuration is shown. Refer to the drawings on the following pages for appropriate holes to use.


# Supplied Hardware



## Assembly

- 1. Install the two swivel casters at one end of the frame using four 5/16-18 x 5/8" capscrews and four 5/16-18 lock nuts in each.
- Install the two nonswivel casters at the other end using four 5/16-18 x 5/8" capscrews and four 5/16-18 lock nuts in each.




3. Attach the Inside tube to the frame.

#### Nota Cart:

Attach the Inside tube to the inside of the frame at the swivel caster end using two  $5/16-18 \times 1-1/2$ " capscrews and two 5/16-18 lock nuts. The capscrews are inserted from the outside of the frame, see the "Parts List" for clarification.


Be sure to use the proper holes for the Nota chair, see the illustration below.



#### All other Carts:

Attach the Inside tube to the inside of the frame at the nonswivel caster end using two  $5/16-18 \times 1-1/2$ " capscrews and two 5/16-18 lock nuts. The capscrews are inserted from the outside of the frame, see the "Parts List" for clarification.


Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.


- 4. Attach the outside tube to the frame at the other end.
  - Nota Cart:

With the velcro side facing up, attach the outside tube to the outside of the frame at the other end (nonswivel caster end) using two  $5/16-18 \times 1-1/2$ " capscrews and two 5/16-18 lock nuts. The capscrews are inserted from the outside of the frame, see the "Parts List" for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the Nota chair, see the illustration below.




#### All other Carts:

With the velcro side facing up, attach the outside tube to the outside of the frame at the other end (swivel caster end) using two  $5/16-18 \times 1-1/2$ " capscrews and two 5/16-18 lock nuts. The capscrews are inserted from the outside of the frame, see the "Parts List" for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.




# Assembly (continued)

5. Attach the inside and outside tubes together using two 2-1/4" capscrews and two 5/16-18 lock nuts. The capscrews are inserted from the outside of the frame, see the "Parts List" for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.



# Assembly (continued)

6. Attach the two bumpers to the inside tubes using two #6 x 1/2" screws in each.



7. Be sure that all capscrews and lock nuts are tightened securely before using the Chair Move & Store Cart.

# Cart Use

The following decal should be located on the top side of one of the casters. It shows the recommended quantities and positions for chairs on the cart.
